The Board consists of (7) seven members, (3) three appointed by the City Commission of the City of St. Johns; (4) four appointed by the St. Johns Public Schools Board of Education. The term of appointment is for (4) four years. Trustees are eligible for re-appointment to a second consecutive 4-year term.

The Library Board exists to responsibly manage the Library's resources with the mission of providing easily accessible services, materials and programs to people of all ages in the Library's service area to meet their evolving recreational, cultural, informational and educational needs. The Briggs District Library Board of Trustees meets once a month. Dates and times are determined annually. Currently the Board meets on the fourth Thursday of the month at 6:00pm at the Library. Meetings are open to the public.
