



## A fun-infused way to learn a new language

### Creating an account (1<sup>st</sup> time only)

1. Go to [briggsdistrictlibrary.org/internet-links](http://briggsdistrictlibrary.org/internet-links) and click on the Mango Languages link
2. Create a profile at the top of the page, this allows Mango to keep track of your progress as you work through lessons
  - a. Click the "Sign Up" button
  - b. Choose a language you would like to study
    - i. You can choose from the pre-selected list, search for a language, or click "See All Languages" for a list of all available languages
  - c. Fill out the required form and click "Create Free Profile"

**\*You can use Mango as a guest by entering your library card number (p12345), if you do not want Mango to track your progress for you\***

3. After creating a Mango profile, you can download the Mango App for Android or ios
  - a. You cannot use the Mango app without first creating a profile

### Using Mango (Website or app)

1. Audio is featured heavily in Mango, so speakers and/or headphones are needed to use the program; a microphone may also be useful, but is not required
2. Each language consists of 2 Units and specialty courses. Each unit has multiple chapters, and each chapter is made of a series of lessons. The lessons, chapters, and units are cumulative – each one builds on the information that came before – and are designed to be used in order
3. Each lesson consists of dozens of slides that introduce new words, phrases, grammar rules, etc.
4. Use the right or left arrows to navigate between slides.
5. Use the button at the top of a slide to toggle between understood or literal translations of the phrase being taught
6. The microphone button at the bottom of a slide allows for voice comparison (a microphone is needed to use this function)
7. The speaker button repeats the phrase and gives a phonetic translation
8. The replay button (curved arrow) repeats the entire lesson
9. The keyboard icon at the top (website version only) displays keyboard shortcuts for navigating the lessons
10. The gear icon is the settings menu that allows the user to add or remove the narrator, closed captions, increase the volume, etc.
  - Clicking "Exit" (website) or the back arrow (app) returns to the main menu
