- A. Renovation Project
  - 1. Review of Expenditures to Date
    - a. Refrigerators were purchased from Kurt's Appliance
    - b. Morrison and Harger met with Pottervilla and ordered tech equipment
    - c. Public furniture has been chosen, still waiting for finishes for office furniture
  - 2. Update on Progress
    - a. Still on track to finish mid-January
- B. Personnel Manual Changes
  - 1. Spreadsheet
    - a. Morrison met with Darragh and Silvernail to discuss changes required by changes in State law
      - 1) Part-time staff will earn 1 hour of PTO and 1 hour of Sick Time for every 30 hours worked
        - (a) More than what will be required by new law
      - 2) Full-time staff will not be able to use more than 160 hours in a calendar year
        - (a) 160 hours is the current cap
        - (b) After 160 hours staff are eligible for long-term disability
      - Part-time staff will not be able to use more than 80 hours in a calendar year
  - 2. Draft Sent to Attorney for Review
    - a. Expect to have change for Board approval at December meeting

  - 1. Daman moved to approve the Closure Schedule; supported by Darragh; motion carried unanimously
  - 2. MCD Addendum 2
    - a. Covers work that has been completed, but was not a part of Addendum 1
